The Parshah in a Nutshell

Pekudei

Exodus 38:21-40:38

Garments of the
High Priest
בגדי כהן הגדול



"You shall make holy garments for your brother Aharon, for honor and for glory.

And you shall speak to all the wise hearted, whom I have filled with the spirit of wisdom, and they shall make Aharon's garments to sanctify him, so that he shall serve Me.

And these are the garments that they shall make: a choshen, an ephod, a robe, a tunic of checker work, a cap, and a sash. They shall make holy garments for your brother Aharon and for his sons to serve Me.

And you shall make a shouplate of pure gold, and you shall engrave upon it like the engraving of a seal: Holy to HaShem.

And make for them linen pants to cover the flesh of their nakedness; they shall reach from the waist down to the thighs." (Exodus 28:2-4, 36, 42)



Each Temple vessel restored by the Temple Institute is kosher and will be used in the soon to be rebuilt Third Temple, made according to the exact requirements and specifications of Biblical law. Please donate generously to help the sacred work of the Temple Institute! Every contribution helps to rebuild the Holy Temple in our Time!

An accounting is made of the gold, silver and copper donated by the people for the making of the Mishkan. Betzalel, Aholiav and their assistants make the eight priestly garments—the apron, breastplate, cloak, crown, hat, tunic, sash and breeches—according to the specifications communicated to Moses in the Parshah of Tetzaveh.

The Mishkan is completed and all its components are brought to Moses, who erects it and anoints it with the holy anointing oil, and initiates Aaron and his four sons into the priesthood. A cloud appears over the Mishkan, signifying the Divine Presence that has come to dwell within it.

WELCOME TO OUR COMMUNITY

We are indeed fortunate that two young doctors have decided to take up residence in St.Martin. Both will have offices at 1039 Notre Dame. Dr.Rubin M.Feldman received his BSc from McGill and is married to Minnie Bistritsky. They moved to France where he attended medical school at the University of Montpellier, while his wife worked as a teacher. They have a son who was born in France. Upon their return, he interned at the Jewish General and the Queen Mary Veteran's Hospital. He is assistant resident in medicine of the University Medical Clinic which is a research unit of the Montreal General Hospital. He is also on staff at the Jean Talon Hospital. Dr. Sidney Feldman is not related to Dr. Rubin Feldman. He attended Folk Shule in Montreal until he was 16, and he speaks Hebrew fluently. He attended McGill University where he received his BSc. He is single and he also went to France to study medicine at the Universite de Paris. In 1953 he went to Israel with a group of French students. He stayed on when the rest returned to France , where he worked at Mishmar Hanegev and at K'far Saba Hospital.

Upon his return to Montreal in 1955 he interned at the Jewish General. From there he went to Florida and spent a year at the Orange Memorial Hospital in Orlando. From there he spent a year at the famous Cleveland Clinic, and upon his return to Montreal he spent a year at the Queen Mary Veterans Hospital. In 1959 he wrote a paper on diabetes in pregnancy which was presented to the Universite de Paris. He is also a teacher at McGill in internal medicine. They will be on call to our community 24/7 and are equipped to handle any emergencies.


