PARSHAT HASHAVUA - WEEKLY TORAH PORTION
The Parshah in a Nutshell

TAZRIA

Leviticus 12:1-13:59



The Parshah of Tazria continues the discussion of the laws of tumah v'taharah, ritual impurity and purity.

A woman giving birth should undergo a process of purification, which includes immersing in a mikvah (a naturally gathered pool of water) and bringing offerings to the Holy Temple. All male infants are to be circumcised on the eighth day of life.

Tzaraat (often mistranslated as "leprosy") is a supra-natural plague, which also can afflict garments. If white or pink patches appear on a person's skin (dark red or green in garments), a kohen is summoned. Judging by various signs, such as an increase in size of the afflicted area after a seven-day quarantine, the kohen pronounces it tamei (impure) or tahor (pure).

A person afflicted with tzaraat must dwell alone outside of the camp (or city) until he is healed. The afflicted area in a garment is removed; if the tzaraat spreads or recurs, the entire garment must be burned.

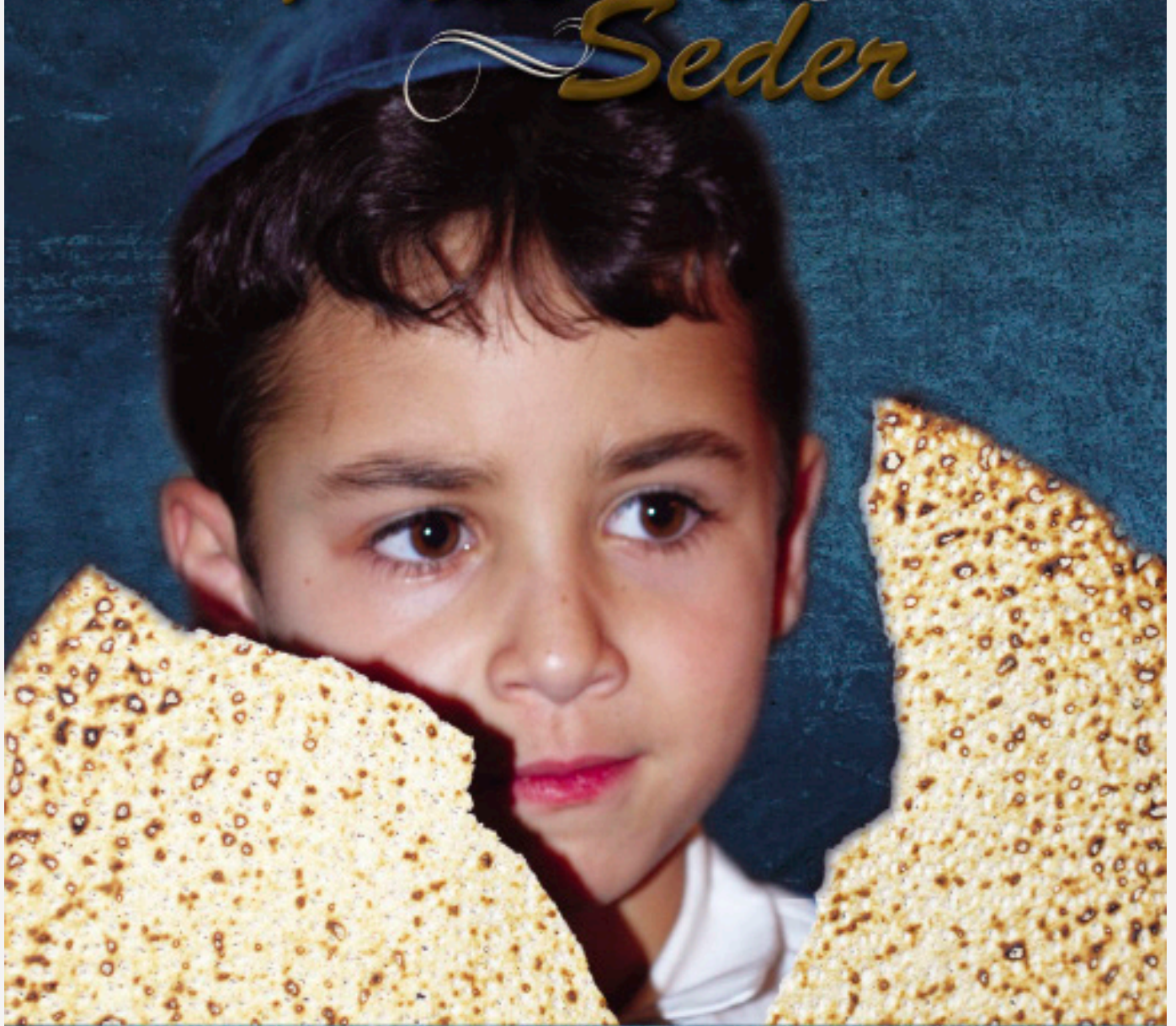

Delegation of Power of Attorney for Sale of Chometz Pesach 5779 (2019)

I, the undersigned, fully empower and permit Rabbi Avram Banon, to act in my place and stead, and on my behalf to sell all Chometz possessed by me, knowingly or unknowingly as defined by the Torah and Rabbinical Law (e.g. Chometz, possible Chometz, and all kinds of Chometz mixtures, including Chometz that tends to harden and adhere to inside surfaces of pans, pots, or cooking utensils, and all kinds of live animals and pets that have been eating Chometz and mixtures thereof).

Rabbi Avram Banon is also empowered to lease all places wherein the Chometz owned by me may be found, particularly in the premises located

at _____, and _____, and elsewhere.

Rabbi Avram Banon has full right to appoint any agent or substitute in his stead and said substitute shall have full right to sell and lease as provided herein.

Rabbi Avram Banon also has the full power and right to act as he deems fit and proper in accordance with all the details of the Bill of Sale used in the transaction to sell all my Chometz, Chometz mixtures, etc., as provided herein.

This power is in conformity with all Torah and Rabbinical laws and also in accordance with the laws of the province of Quebec and of Canada.
